**ORDER GRANTING “APPELLANTS’ UNOPPOSED MOTION TO  
CONTINUE EVIDENTIARY HEARING” AND NOTICE OF HEARING**

Appellants J.C. Baker & Son, Inc. and Baker Oil Company, having moved the West Virginia Environmental Quality Board (“Board”), unopposed, for a continuance of the evidentiary hearing, the Board grants the *Motion*.
