This is one of the appeals that has been here for awhile, and we've been waiting on the reissuance of the permit at which time it will make this moot. Fortunately, I do have somewhat of a quick time frame or some feedback from my client on a time frame. A draft permit is really close to being issued. In fact, my client informed me that they're going to try to get a

I think it will allow us to ideally get the permit issued, but at the very least give us a -- we'll be in a good position to give the Board another status update, you know, and let you all know, you know, if it's going to be much further than that with the amount of comments to work through. But I think a 60-days continuance in this one is prudent given the circumstances.

CHAIRMAN SNYDER: Yeah, the Board has always recognized the importance of not only public
