The proceedings will be recorded and transcribed later, if necessary. The following will be discussed at the prehearing:

- (1) Presentation and consideration of preliminary legal issues;
- (2) Stipulations to facts that are not contested by the parties;

(3) Stipulations to the admission of evidence to avoid unnecessary proof;

(4) Identification and reduction of number of witnesses; and

(5) Consideration of any other matters that will aid in the expeditious

conduct of the hearing.

It is further ordered that each counselor representative attending the prehearing conference is

required to have a thorough knowledge of the case, be prepared to discuss it, and to make stipulations or

admissions where appropriate and to argue any pending motions. Each counselor representative must

have full authority from the party represented and any law firm with which associated to take such action

as may be necessary to comply with this order.

It is further ordered that at the conclusion of the conference, either orally for the record or by separate

writing, an order will be entered which recites any action taken and agreements reached by the parties.

The order will take the place of all that has gone before and will control the subsequent course of the

hearing unless modified to prevent manifest injustice.

The Board also, upon due consideration of the prior arguments of the parties regarding Appellant's

motion for stay and determining that the arguments presented do not establish there would be any

significant risk of environmental harm to the waters of this State or the public while the appeal is pendin,

extends the Stay until January 15, 2024.
