The meeting was to discuss the question of jurisdiction of the Board as it relates to making a decision on appeals of Water Quality Certification under §401 and 404 of the Clean Water Act on an appeal filed by the Upper West Fork River Watershed Association, Inc., (UWFRWA) and Kyle and Icie Bush (Appeal No. 125).
