

NOTES - STATE WATER RESOURCES BOARD MEETING MAY 13 & 14, 1980

The State Water Resources Board met at approximately 9:00 a. m. on the above date at 1205 Greenbrier Street, Charleston, WV for the purpose of reviewing input from the Division of Water Resources and other sources regarding the revision to the Water Quality Standards.

Board members present were: Mr. John C. Ailes, Chairman, Mr. Larry George and Dr. Edward H. Crum - Members. absent: Mr. Kirkpatrick

Division of Water Resources Personnel present were: Mr. Jess Malcolm, Mr. Doug Steele and Mr. John H. Hall.

The entire work copy of regs drafted by the Division were reviewed with suggestions to language, numbers, etc. and some of these were incorporated. A Draft Work Copy should be together for the Board by May 27, 1980 - when they meet again for several hearings.

Also discussed and granted was a Stay of Execution until May 27, 1980 for the New River Company. The Company's attorney-Mr. Willard Sullivan was present along with the Division's representative from the Attorney General's Office - Mr. Robert Pollitt and from the Division of Water Resources, Mr. Paul Ware.

Input to two variances were directed to the Board by Mr. Dave Flannery - Attorney at Law---one for the John Amos Plant and the other for the Ohio Power Company.

Also present were Ms. Ann Bradley and Kim Polan (attorneys) and Mr. Bob Foster with Union Carbide Corp.

WATER RESOURCES BOARD TO MEET
