

January 12, 1981

On this date the proposed water quality standards were filed with Legislative Services for the presentation to the Legislative Rule Making Review Committee which meet at 9 a. m. this date. Chairman Ailes answered questions for this committee on these regulations (William Plass also present).

The Board also filed the final regulation as promulgated December 30, 1980, with the Secretary of State. The rationale for the above was also worked on.

The Board met at 1:00 p. m. the above date and once again review the NPDES working set of regulations - a few changes were made. Board members present were: John Ailes, Forrest H. Kirkpatrick, Don Brannon and William Plass.

Also present were John Hall and Karen Watson (the board member absent was Larry George.)

By unanimous vote it was agreed that Chairman Ailes write a letter of commendation re: Karen Watson to Attorney General Chauncey Browning for her outstanding work with the Board over the past few months.

No definite date was set for the next meeting.

Also on this date it was agreed that an Order was to be entered with a cover letter to the 3M company denying their request for a variance.

It was suggested that a copy of the regulations as filed with the LRMRC be sent to EPA - to the Regional Director and whoever else necessary (Bob Collins, Jeff Haas, etc.).

John Hall of the Division commented on the memo he received regarding the D. O. on the Ohio.
