Motions were entertained on Appeal No. 141 - (see transcript in file for further details) - and Appeal No. 141 was dismissed, Rick Webb vs. Chief.

Also discussed was Appeal No. 136 - Don's Disposal Service, Inc. vs. Chief (Ruthann McQuade representing Chief from the Attorney General's Office) - Ms. McQuade is to discuss with Dave Robinson what regulations pertain to this case - to look at wet weather stream^s and what effect they have on this case. Perhaps permit could be modified to absorb above - if wet weather relief is there - or a variance may be in order - an ORDER will be entered on this date to continue this until further notice.

Mr. Ailes discussed the letter written to the LRRC and so that there will be no misunderstanding of interpretation of the regulations between the promulgating agency and the enforcing agency the Board adopted the concept that they do not and should not do more than establish general guidelines to direct the enforcing agency in carrying out the purposes of the regulations and that the Board should not encroach on the enforcing agency's prerogative to establish its own administrative procedures.

Ruthann McQuade is to submit a letter requesting continuance of the Goodyear Company Appeal No. 140 in a day or so (continuance on motion of the parties) and an ORDER will be prepared when received.

The next meeting of the Board will be August 12th through 16th to work on the hazardous wastes regulations.
