

BOARD NOTES - November 9 & 10, 1981

The Board met on November 9 at 9:00 a. m. to hear appeal Nos. 145 & 146 - members present: John C. Ailes, Wm. Plass & Forrest H. Kirkpatrick. Dr. Don Brannon and Larry George disqualified themselves in this appeal. (see transcript in file).

On November 10, 1981 at 9:00 a. m. the Board heard Appeal No. 143, Rick Webb vs. Chief, Division of Water Resources with Board members John Ailes (Chairman), Dr. Donald Brannon & William Plass present (Mr. Kirkpatrick and Mr. George absent). The Board denied a MOTION FOR A DIRECTED VERDICT presented by the appellee/appellee/intervenor. (see transcript in file for more details).

On the 10th the members as above met briefly with Karen Watson and Ruthann McQuade on the Hazardous Waste, UIC and FOI regulations and a schedule was set up as follows for the promulgating of the HW & other business as follows:
