

Board Notes/Minutes - May 19, 1982

Water Resources Board met on this date with members Plass, Ailes, George & Brannon present - Kirkpatrick absent.

Purpose of meeting to resolve in full Appeal 143 - after Mr. Ailes, Chairman, putting a question to board members it was agreed that Mr. Ailes and Mr. Plass would meet separately from Mr. George and Dr. Brannon because they did not agree on sustaining the order of the Chief and that separate Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law would be prepared and submitted. (Mr. George and Dr. Brannon would amend the permit based upon their findings).

Also discussed briefly was the request of the W.V. Manufacturer's Association (petition) for Rule-Making re: the Hazardous Waste Regulations. The Board also discussed the former Ailes Committee's work on perpetual treatment of acid mine drainage and perhaps the reconvening of same. Mr. Plass had suggested the Board get back to the coal association on the problems they faced with the water quality standards and a tentative date of June 29th was set for the next Board meeting - same location and to begin at 9:00 a. m.

The date of June 2, 1982, was set to hear Appeal 156 - Beckley Coal Mining Corp. with a possible continuance to be submitted.
