

MINUTES OF THE STATE WATER RESOURCES BOARD

The State Water Resources Board met on January 3 & 4, 1983, with the following members present: John C. Ailes, Chairman, Robert B. Scott - member, David E. Samuel - member and William T. Plass - member.

Appeal No. 157 - Three Runs Woods Home Owners, et. al, Appellants, v. Chief, Division of Water Resources, Appellee and Camelot Home Owners Association, Intervenor/Appellee was held. This had been continued from December 8, 1982 - see transcript in file.

The Board held discussion on the first draft of the landfill regulations under 20-5E.

By proper motion and vote taken the UIC regulations that went to public notice on October 28 were approved - Mr. Plass made the motion and Dr. Samuel seconded - all in favor "ayed" no "nays".

Mrs. Watson also presented to the board procedural regulations implementing the authorization by rule provision of the regulations for the W. Va. Underground Injection Control Program and after discussion and proper motion and vote taken (same as above) the Board adopted these regulations which will be put out for a 30 day comment period and filed with the Secretary of State as soon as possible.

No definite date was set for the next board meeting.
