By proper motion and vote the following action(s) were taken:

After presentation by Mr. David Flannery, attorney, for the W. Va. Manufacturers' Association, move was made and seconded to incorporate their 1st Petition with Modifications to the Hazardous Waste Management Regulations. (December 20, 1982 letter)

Order was entered for continuance of Appeal No. 169, Potomac Edison (to be scheduled any time after 30 days).

Next meeting of the board scheduled for February 22, 1983.

Note-board also agreed to Karen Watson, Assistant Attorney General, sending a letter voicing their views along with Mr. Robinson's (Chief) to EPA on their new proposed draft water quality standard regulations.
