

MINUTES - Board Meeting - June 20, 1983

The State Water Resources Board met on above date at 9:00 a. m. in conference room located at 1201 Greenbrier Street, Charleston, with the following members present: Mr. Ailes, Chairman; members Dr. Allen Hamner, Mr. Robert Scott & Mr. William Plass. Absent: Dr. David Samuel.

The purpose of the meeting was to hear further considerations of suggestions for the review of water quality standards and the Board heard from representatives of the Coal Association & the W. Va. Reclamation & Surface Mining Association; the W. Va. Manufacturers Association and the W. Va. Citizens' Action Group. D. Robinson, Chief - Division of Water Resources also stated that the Division would have some input for the Board's consideration.

After discussion on various parts of the standards, a tentative schedule as follows was developed for implementation of these regulations:

July 11, 12 & 13th - Board would go over suggestions and have proposal ready for typing.

August 1 - Proposed revisions, etc. out to public notice and copy filed with the Office of the Secretary of State.

September 15th or thereabouts - Public hearing on proposed revisions, etc.

September 30th - Close of comment period.

October 15th - Adopt and file regulations with the Secretary of State and the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee.

The Board met in the afternoon in executive session for the purpose of interviewing prospective employees.

At 7:00 the Board heard comments on the proposed groundwater protection standard - list of attendees of each meeting/hearing attached.

Next meeting set for July 11, 12, 13th unless something should come up before then.
