

MINUTES BOARD MEETING JANUARY 9, 1984 - 1260 Greenbrier Street, Charleston, WV

At the request of the LRMC the Board met with Division of Water Resources personnel and the representative of Weirton Steel - Mr. Houston Wood re: variance request that the Legislative Rule Making Review Committee had directed the Board to achieve at this meeting. Variance request pertained to temperature - Harmon Creek - from mouth to approx. 2.2 miles upstream to outfall in question. Temperature to be 5^o difference - a maximum of 90^oF instead of 87^oF. It was understood at the close of the discussion that the Division would be amendable to extend the compliance time schedule for temperature in the draft permit. No further action until draft permit issued on this request.

Board also entered ORDER in Appeal No. 193, Howes Leather Company, Inc. Variance on Howes is to be settled as soon as possible - but it is noted that the variance will not solve all issues and a hearing will most likely need to be scheduled in the future.
