The Board also ruled on the Petition for Suspension of Order and Certain Terms and Conditions of Water Pollution Control Permit received by Quaker State Oil - Appeal No. 268 - see transcript in file. The Motion to Suspend was denied until Appellant's attorney could represent client. The Board accepted and entered Monongahela Power Company's appeals 272, 273 and 274.

The Board also by proper motion and vote agreed to a Stay in Ohio Power Company's Appeal No. 276. (see transcript in file)
Note - a partial Consent Order was received by the Board on February 14 in above Carbide appeal.
