

Board Minutes

May 14, 1986

The Board met at 9:00 a. m. in conference room at 1260 Greenbrier Street with all four members present.

The Board heard Appeal No. 318 Malden PSD (see transcript in file) and by proper motion and vote granted the Motion to Dismiss filed by Appellee, Chief.

A status report was received on Riverton Coal (see file).

The Board also received testimony in Appeal Nos. 289, 298 and 290 Viking Coal (see transcript in file).

Mr. Parsons also discussed the Board's authority under the Hazardous Waste Management Act W. va. Code 20-5E-19 and there was general discussion of revisions to the Procedural Regs Series IV and Series VII Groundwater Standards.

The Board also entered an Order continuing Appeal No. 319 West Liberty State College generally.

The Board entered a Consent Order in Appeal No. 310 Village of Beech Bottom and Appeal No. 312 - Brooke County PSD - dismissing them.

Mrs. Watson, Assistant Attorney General advised the Board she had received an Order in the Kaiser Appeal No. 280 but had not had a chance to review it and would get back to the Board in a few days.
