

Minutes of Board Hearing/Meeting

October 12, 1988

The Board met in their conference room at 1260 Greenbrier Street, Charleston, WV at 9:00 a.m. with all three members present (Ailes, Plass and Samuel).

The Board was advised that requests for continuance of Appeal Nos. 394 and 393 (Black Gold) had been received along with a request for continuance in Appeal No. 392 - Sharon & Julian Garnes (Fleming Landfill). By proper motion and vote (unanimous) the Board agreed to continue these cases. A Motion to Intervene in Appeal No. 392 had been filed by Fleming's counsel and the Board accepted the Motion.

The Board heard counsel for Rhone Poulenc and counsel for the State (appeal No. 362) present a request for continuance in this case. The Board agreed to do so (see transcript in file).

Status reports were also given in Badger Coal, Wheeling Pittsburgh Steel, Borg Warner, Mid Atlantic Fuels and Viking Coal. Stipulations on appeal No. 331 (FMC) were to be submitted to the Board along with photos - this was to be a joint stipulation.

On this date the Board adopted the proposed Series 1-Title 46 Requirements Governing Water Quality Standards and they are to be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State and with the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee. Notices of hearings are attached.
